ADMISSION: FY DEGREE PROGRAMS 2019-20

Candidates Applying for the above courses should note the criteria of eligibility for admissions. Admissions shall be granted on merit at qualifying examination as per criteria in accordance with the circular of Univ. of Mumbai:

Eligibility for Admission to F.Y.B.A.: Candidate for applying for FYBA must have passed HSC examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination from stream of Arts/Commerce/Science. Admission will be based on merit at qualifying examination.

Eligibility for Admission to F.Y.B.Sc.: Candidate for applying for FYB.Sc. must have passed HSC examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination from stream of Science. Admission will be based on merit at qualifying examination.

Eligibility for Admission to F.Y.B.Com.: Candidate for applying for FYB.Com. must have passed HSC examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination from stream of Commerce. Admission will be based on merit at qualifying examination.

Eligibility for Admission to F.Y.B.M.M.: Candidate for applying for FYBMM must have passed HSC examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination from stream of Arts/Commerce/Science. Admission will be based on merit at qualifying examination.

Eligibility for Admission to F.Y.B.Sc.: Candidate for applying for FYBMM must have passed HSC examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination from stream of Arts/Commerce/Science. Admission will be based on merit at qualifying examination.

Eligibility for Admission to F.Y.B.M.S.: Candidate for applying for FYBMS must have passed HSC examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination or Diploma in any Engineering branch with two/three/four years' duration after SSC conducted by Board of technical Education, Maharashtra State or its equivalent examination with 45% marks for general category (in one attempt) and 40% marks for reserved category (in one attempt) at the qualifying examination.

Eligibility for Admission to F.Y.B.Sc. (Information Technology-IT): Candidate for applying for FYBSc-IT must have passed HSC examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination **with Mathematics and Statistics** as one of the subject with 45% marks for general category and 40% marks for reserved category at the qualifying examination.

Admission will be on merit based on order of merit as follows:

- i) Marks in Mathematics and Statistics at H.S.C. or equivalent
- ii) Aggregate Marks at H.S.C (Std. XII) or equivalent
- iii) Aggregate Marks at S.S.C (Std. X)

Eligibility for Admission to F.Y.B.Sc. (Computer Science-CS): Candidate for applying for FYBSc-CS must have passed HSC examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent one **with Mathematics and Statistics** as one of the subject with Mathematics & Statistics as one of the subject.

Admission will be based on order of merit at qualifying examinations as follows

- i) Aggregate marks in H.S.C or equivalent examination
- ii) Aggregate marks in Science group: Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics-PCM.
- iii) Marks in Mathematics, Statistics and Physics
- iv) Marks in Mathematics & Statistics

Eligibility for Admission to F.Y.B.Sc. (Biotechnology-BT)

Candidate for applying for FYBSc-CS must have passed HSC examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination **with Mathematics and Statistics** as one of the subject:

Admission will be on order of merit at the qualifying examinations as follows:

- i) Aggregate marks in HSC or its equivalent
- ii) Aggregate marks in Science group (Physics, Chemistry & Biology)
- iii) Marks in Biology & Chemistry
- iv) Marks in Biology

A candidate who has not offered Mathematics and Statistics as one of the subject at H.S.C. shall have to complete a course on Mathematics and Statistics (of 15 hours' duration) during the academic year of First year B.Sc.

If any candidate is admitted to any of the above program due to wrong information provided by candidate / oversight, and the candidate is not eligible for the said course due to non-fulfillment of criteria relating to passing percentage or subjects offered at qualifying examination, the admission will automatically stand cancelled and the candidate should claim refund of fees as per rules.
