- b. **Original mark sheet** only for verification except boards other than SSC, Along with 2 photocopies. (please keep sufficient photocopies with you)
- c. Eligibility students (for students other than Maharashtra Board) Those student who have completed their 10th from Board other than Maharashtra Board should submit their Eligibility form and Deed of undertaking, original L.C./ T.C, Migration with 2 copies and marksheet and passing Cert. 2 copies each at the time of admission and pay Eligibility fees Rs. 850.
- d. **Original school leaving certificate** (to be retained by college authority). Along with 2 photocopies.
- e. **Caste certificate** issued by the competent authority appointed **by Government of Maharashtra** (applicable in case of backward category students domiciled in Maharashtra). Along with 2 photocopies
- f. In case of EWS admissions income certificate is required
- g. Non creamy layer certificate wherever applicable. (Except for open, SC, ST category)
