### ADMISSION POLICY

- Bhavan's College is an autonomous college, affiliated to the University of Mumbai.
- The entire admission procedure is conducted in accordance with guidelines as received from the University and policy decisions taken by the governing body of autonomous Bhavan's college.
- The college follows the reservation policy of the Govt for all its aided program and self financing
- Faculty wise <u>admission committees</u> are constituted under the charge of V<u>ice-principal</u> for each faculty, with fair representation of staff members belonging to reserved category
- The entire admission procedure is mostly conducted in accordance with guidelines as received from the University, in the form of circulars, indicating scheduled dates for acceptance of pre-admission forms, display of 1st, 2ndand 3rd merit lists and issuing admissions according to the merit lists though in some cases dates may be differ post autonomy.
- The College uses an ERP CC\_MS system to have their entire admission process in an online digital mode .Thus candidates aspiring for admission to the College have to undergo first, the Registration process for University of Mumbai and fill up the Preadmission Online form through the university website <a href="www.mum.digitaluniversity.ac.in">www.mum.digitaluniversity.ac.in</a>
   This has to be completed within the timeline given by the University
- After registering with the University of Mumbai, registration with the college has to be done through the college website online portal <u>www.bhavans.ac.in</u> within the timeline prescribed.

- The duly filled Registration forms should be accompanied by the Pre-admission form of UoM and required documents viz. Std 10<sup>th</sup> and Std 12<sup>th</sup> Marksheets, Leaving Certificate, and Caste Certificate if applicable.
- The application forms are imported into the Institute's ERP system where the Application Forms and supporting documents are verified.
- After verification, the merit lists are generated and displayed on the website and notice boards of the college as per schedule decided.
- The candidates whose names are within the merit list need to take their admission by paying their fees online through the fee paying portal displayed on the college/ERP website within the stipulated time span failing which they forfeit their seat

### **NOTE:**

- 1. In case of Online Admission process, the student does not have to visit the college during the entire admission process.
- 2. For the Aided Programs, admission is first granted to INHOUSE students, i.e. those who have completed the XIIth Standard from Bhavan's College, <u>subject to the merit list.</u>
- 3. For the Unaided Self-financing Programs, there is no preference for In house students and admissions are purely on merit as per merit list.

# **Admissions: Internal Progression in UG Programmes:**

- Admission for Progression to higher classes is based on merit wrt to Preferences for optional subjects within the intake capacity.
- Counselling whenever necessary is offered for selection of Applied Component subjects and for electives which are offered.

## **Bhavan's college Fees**

The candidate while submitting their registration form will pay their registration fees and only those students who are admitted are requested to pay admission fee based on the <a href="Bhavans">Bhavan's College fee is different based on the courses and the duration of the courses.</a>

### Eligibility

Candidates should have passed Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSC) examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Mumbai, or equivalent examination in the Arts, Science or Commerce streams can apply for the Bhavans UG courses admission based on the eligibility criteria.

### **ADMISSION AND EXIT PATH:**

### Year 1 for UG course:

- Entry eligibility: level 4 or grade 12 school leaving certificate
- Exit 1 with award of level 5 certificate: at the end of 1 year with 36-40 credit additional an exit 10 credit bridge course lasting for 2 months including atleast 6 credit job specific internship/apprenticeship that would help the graduate acquire job ready competencies required to enter the work force

### Year 2 for UG course:

• Entry 2 level 6: eligibility certificate obtained after completing the first year of UG

Exit 2: award of level 6 diploma at end of 2 year with 72-80 credits from level 5 to 6, followed by an exit 10 credit NSQF COMPLIANT SKILL BASED COURSE LASTING FOR 2 MONTHS

#### Year 3 for UG Course:

- Entry 3 level 7: eligibility diploma obtained after completing 2 years of UG
- Exit 3: award of level 7 bachelor's degree at end of 3 year with 108-120 credits from level 5 to 7, followed by an exit 10 credit bridge course

#### Year 4 for UG Course:

- Entry 4 level 8: minimum CGPA of 7.5 at the 3 year bachelor degree
- Exit 4: award of level 8 bachelor's degree(honors/research) after 4 yrs with total of 144-160 credits from level 5 to 8
- Students can enter or reenter only at the odd semester and can exit only after the even semester
- Reentry at various levels as lateral entrants in an academic program in the same or different institutions shall be only on the basis of the earned credits and proficiency test records

#### **ACADEMIC BANK OF CREDITS**

Through national level online facility that will help in credit accumulation, credit transfer and credit redemption so that the mobility of students across HEI will be facilitated.

#### PURSING TWO ACADEMIC PROGRAMS SIMULTANEOUSLY

- Students can pursue two full time academic programs in physical mode if class timings do not overlap
- They can pursue two programs one in physical mode and another in ODL Mode
- They can pursue two ODL/online programs

In case of ODL 60% of self learning material developed in house have to be selected and rest can be sourced from OER, SWAYAM and other approved agencies.

## **ADMISSIONS TO MASTERS PROGRAMMES:**

- The College offers M.Sc. by Research and M.Sc. by Papers in Botany, Chemistry, Microbiology, Physics, Zoology, and Biodiversity, Wildlife Conservation and Management for its 10 aided and 10 unaided seats
- The merit list for admission are allocated on merit by the College from applications received from eligible candidates.
- If the number of applicants is high an entrance exam may also be conducted by the college, the date of which will be notified on the website.
- Applications received for M.Sc. Research Programs are processed at the Departmental level based on the available seats.
- From the Academic year 2022-23, the college has started M.A. in Economics and M.A. in Psychology.

 Admission to M.A. Economics is direct for B.A. Economics students. Students having completed B.Com. degree are required to give an entrance test for admission to the Masters programme

### **ADMISSIONS TO PH.D. PROGRAMMES:**

- The College enrols students for Ph.D. Programmes in Botany, Chemistry, Microbiology and Zoology.
- The college RDC (Research and Development Cell) will conduct bi-annual entrance examinations for Ph.D. Programmes (PET) for the number of vacant seats, is published on the college website.
- The Research & Development Cell (RDC) of our College will arrange for the interviews for the eligible candidates after due scrutiny of the applications and College PET results. The interview panel is duly constituted as per the University Circular and the interviews are conducted within 30 days of the declaration of the PET results.
- After interviews, list of selected candidates is displayed on the notice board and College website, individual candidates are intimated and admitted to the programme.

### **CERTIFICATE COURSES:**

The college conducts Certificate Courses in Vedic Maths, Python Programming, MS Office and Health Psychology and details of which will be displayed •
